VATICAN CITY, AUG 15, 2020 / 06:10 am MT (CNA).- On the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Pope Francis said that Mary's assumption into Heaven was an infinitely greater achievement than man's first steps on the moon. "When man set foot on the moon, he said a phrase that became famous: 'That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind.' In essence, humanity had reached a historic milestone. But today, in Mary's Assumption into Heaven, we celebrate an infinitely greater achievement. Our Lady set foot in Heaven," Pope Francis said Aug. 15. "This step of the little Virgin of Nazareth was the giant leap forward of mankind," the pope added.
