WELCOME FATHER JOHN BOLDERSON

I am Fr. John. Before priesthood I spent four years in the Marine Corps. The first year and a half I was an enlisted Marine and the rest as a commissioned officer. After the Corps I checked out the Franciscan Order. I was a brother in simple vows when my spiritual director suggested the ordinary priesthood. I was ordained in 1981 and have never regretted it. About two years ago my health issues (mostly heart) caused my retirement. Soon after that, I fell and broke my right arm and neck. I faced death three times but always ended up stronger. The bishop asked me to take St. Ann and St. Cyril. I gladly said yes. I do not know how long I will serve you. That is really up to God and the bishop. I will do the best I can. I do not consider myself heavy-handed or harsh. I am here to serve. I am looking at Mass times but will change nothing without input from the people. This is not "my" parish. This is "our" parish. For now, let's just get to know each other.
