parish family.

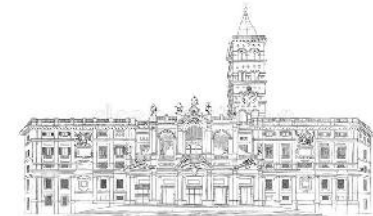
**The 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Pitching for Priests**

**Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary  
Major Aug.5** Saint Mary Major is one of  
the four basilicas in which the pilgrims to  
Rome must pray in order to gain the  
indulgences of the Holy Year. Most fitting
