FROM FR. MATTHEW:

From Monday, June 26th until Friday, July 14th, I will be away from Independence. Unfortunately, I was unable to find priests to offer the weekday Masses at Saint Mary's and Saint Cyril's. This means that from June 26th until July 13th there will be no weekday Masses at Saint Mary's or Saint Cyril's and no Eucharistic adoration at Saint Cyril's. I am very sorry to be unable to provide Holy Mass at your parish, but I trust that you will be able to attend weekday Masses at neighboring parishes.

The Labor Mariae Sisters, who have just begun their life and their apostolate at Saint Mary's has as one of their charisms the promotion of Eucharistic Adoration. Eucharistic Adoration is the highest form of homage we can give to God and a great source of graces for individuals and for our communities.

With the blessing of the sisters coming to live at the St. Mary's convent, and the fact that they have one vehicle to share - we are trying to determine how best to accommodate the desire they have for Adoration - we anticipate offering some sessions at St. Mary's each week - and to give options for those limited by travel or those who are currently traveling a distance.

We are considering how to modify Adoration - the St. Cyril's participation is not what we would like it to be. We are considering changing the time frame in Sugar Creek - we would offer Adoration from end of Mass on Monday/prayer group until mid/late morning on Tuesday.

A schedule is in back to church - we will populate with those who are currently participating, but please indicate both your first and second preference, and would you be willing to consider 90 minute adoration? That will help us determine what schedule might work when we make the change mid July.
