Labor Mariae Sisters - Official beginning of the Labor Mariae Sisters. On Friday, June 9th, there will be a Solemn High Mass (in the Extraordinary Form) in honor of Our Lady, Mother of Divine Grace, offered on the occasion of the beginning of Labor Mariae and entrance of the first postulants.
