Diocesan Guidelines for Attending Mass
 St. Cyril's Parishioners were allowed to come back to Sunday Mass on May 17, 2020. Attendance is not required at this time. We will be observing Social Distancing and other Health Requirements for the Celebration of Mass. The pews utilized by the assembly shall be wiped down with disinfectant. All hymnals and missalettes are removed from the pews. People are welcome to bring their own books to use during Mass. Holy water fonts are to remain empty until further notice. The faithful are obliged to wear a mask upon entering the church and during the celebration of Mass, except when remaining in the pew and for the brief moment of receiving Holy Communion. Pews are marked off so families can maintain social distancing from other families. Processions of the Gifts are suspended. When receiving Communion, please observe six-foot distancing in a single file line. Stationary collection baskets are to be used for donations from the assembly. They will be at both entrances of Church. Entry and exit doors will be propped open before Mass and after Mass to prevent people from touching the door handles, knobs or push plates.
