We have Mystic Monk coffee available in back of church. All bags and the variety boxes of K-cups are all \$10.00 each.

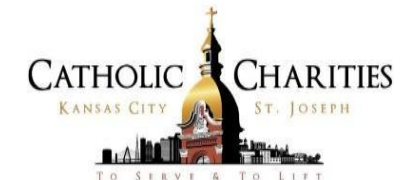
