The gift cards make a large impact because it's one of the tools used to continue providing care to men and women facing an unplanned pregnancy.

New Mom Care Packages and Dad Bags: When a woman finds out she is pregnant, they offer her an ultrasound, and invite her to return to Rachel House for an appointment where she can learn about the many resources they can offer her throughout her pregnancy. These bags are given to the fathers while they are in the Fatherhood education program.
