RACHEL HOUSE

Due to the Covid 19 virus, we will not have our annual Altar Society Christmas Party this year. As we have in the past several years, we will donate to Rachel House to help men and women in our community facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Rachel House staff has given us ways we can help: \$5 QT Gift Cards: The cards are given as a thank you to the clients at their first appointment. The clients are able to use the gift cards to pay for gas to make it to their next appointment, whether an ultrasound, education classes or case management appointments. The gift cards make a large impact because it's one of the tools used to continue providing care to men and women facing an unplanned pregnancy.

New Mom Care Packages and Dad Bags: When a woman finds out she is pregnant, they offer her an ultrasound, and invite her to return to Rachel House for an appointment where she can learn about the many resources they can offer her throughout her pregnancy. As an incentive, they offer those who come for that appointment a nice tote bag filled with wonderful things just for them. They also give a similar gift for dads and call them Dad Bags. These bags are given to the fathers while they are in the Fatherhood education program.

NEW MOM CARE PACKAGE Pick a tote for a young woman and fill it with these items: \$5 QT Gift card, \$5 Target or Walmart Gift card, cute travel water bottle, nail polish, pampering beauty products.

DAD BAG: Fill a backpack diaper bag with 1 of each of the following: Blanket, pacifier, sleeper, onesie, baby wash, baby lotion, diaper cream, toy, baby bottle, package of Diapers (size 2), and package of wipes.
