First Day of Autumn is September 23, 2019.

Exposition of the Eucharist and Benediction at St. Ann's Beginning on Thursday, September 5, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration every Thursday after the 8 AM Mass. Exposition will conclude with Benediction at 12 noon. A sign-up sheet is available in the back of the church in order to ensure that at least two persons are present throughout the period of Exposition. From the Manual of Indulgences: A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who visit the Blessed Sacrament for adoration lasting at least a half hour. A partial indulgence is granted to the faithful who visit the Blessed Sacrament for adoration; and a partial indulgence is granted to the faithful who offer any duly approved prayer to Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament.
