### Saint Charles Place: A Permanent Housing for Low-Income Seniors in St. Joseph, MO.

Catholic Charities of Kansas City-St. Joseph was recently awarded a \$6.2 million Low-Income Housing Tax Credit project from the Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC) to build permanent housing units for low-income seniors in St. Joseph, Missouri. Saint Charles Place units are open for seniors at or below 30-60% area median income. Most of the units are two bedrooms and will be single story, ground-level entry buildings. Rent ranges from \$185.00 to \$550.00, depending on income. The building will take from 9-12 months to complete and as we get closer to completion, we'll announce more information regarding how to apply for a unit.
